The group also discussed the need to get more active participation from HHS Seniors. **Michael agreed to follow-up with Mr. Pierce to determine when the next Sr. meeting will be held so we can potentially give a presentation.**

**Karen is going to follow-up with HHS Athletics to confirm the use of HHS Stadium for the 8K.** Kelsea Sadler, Karen's daughter, joined the group and indicated she would approach the Leo Club for assistance as well as spread the work about the Facebook page to other Sr.'s. Students may be able to sell T-shirts during lunch or cake balls.

**Teresa Hodge is going to follow-up with a baker she knows that is starting a business who might consider preparing cake balls for cost for in kind advertising.**

Jodie pitched the idea of having a book sale fundraiser which she would lead. Several members thought it was worth exploring.

Sue Duncum indicated she would explore Donkey Basketball as another potential fundraiser. Possible location would be Buda City Park pavilion.
